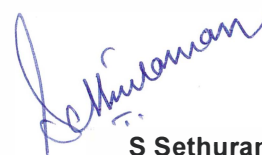
### To the Board of Directors of Chemplast Sanmar Limited

- 1 In terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) 2015, this Statement of Unaudited Standalone Financial Results for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December 2024 ("Unaudited Standalone Financial Results") of Chemplast Sanmar Limited (the "Company") has been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 7th February 2025 and have been subjected to a limited review by the statutory auditor of the Company. An unmodified conclusion was issued by them thereon.
- 2 The Unaudited Standalone Financial Results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended) and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (Listing Requirements).
- 3 The Company's operations predominantly relate to manufacture and sale of Speciality Chemicals. As the Company's business activity falls within a single business segment viz 'Speciality Chemicals' and the sales substantially being in the domestic market, and as such there is no other separate reportable segment as per Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments".
- 4 During the previous quarter, the Company had elected to exercise the option permitted under section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 with effect from FY 2023-24. Accordingly the Deferred Tax Liability (net) as at 31st March, 2024 and the tax expense for quarter ended 30th September 2024 was remeasured at a lower rate of tax. The cumulative impact of this change i.e. reversal of deferred tax liability, recognized in the Statement of Profit and Loss and other comprehensive income is INR 18.41 crores and INR 45.07 crores respectively for the quarter ended 30th September 2024 and nine months ended 31st December, 2024.
- 5 The previous period/ year comparatives have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary to conform to the current period's presentation.

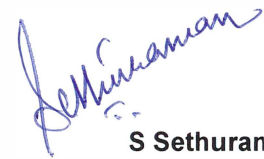

- 1 In terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, this Statement of Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December 2024 ("Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results") of Chemplast Sanmar Limited (the "Holding Company" or the "Company") and Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited, its wholly owned subsidiary (the Holding company and its Subsidiary together referred to as the "Group") has been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 7th February 2025 and have been subjected to a limited review by the statutory auditor of the Company. An unmodified conclusion is issued by them thereon.
- 2 The Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of the Group have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended) and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (Listing Requirements).
- 3 The Board of Directors of the Holding Company, who have been identified as the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), evaluates the Group's performance, allocate resources based on the analysis of the various performance indicators of the Group into manufacture and sale of speciality chemicals and commodity chemicals as per the requirement of Ind-AS 108 "Operating Segments".
- 4 During the previous quarter, the Holding Company had elected to exercise the option permitted under section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 with effect from FY 2023-24. Accordingly the Deferred Tax Liability (net) as at 31st March, 2024 and the tax expense for the quarter ended 30th September 2024 was remeasured at a lower rate of tax.
