Amendment in Environmental Clearance (EC) dated 16/11/2023 granted to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006 and as amended thereof-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your application submitted to MoEF&CC vide proposal number IA/TN/IND2/427770/2023 dated 05/05/2023 for grant of an amendment in prior Environmental Clearance (EC) to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

2. The particulars of the proposal are as below:

(xiii) Status of implementation of the project

- 3. In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form-1(Part A, B and C) were submitted to the MoEF&CC for an appraisal by the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) Expert Appraisal Committee under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.
- 4. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by EAC (EAC) in the meeting held on 16/05/2023. The minutes of the meeting and all the project documents are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed from the PARIVESH portal by scanning the QR Code above.
- 5. The brief about the reasons for an amendment requested along with comparison table illustrating the details of amendments are given in tabular format as Amendment logs.

During deliberations EAC discussed the following issues:

- PP has informed that post receipt of EC, after detailed engineering there is shortage of land for the proposed expansion. As per existing EC Industry require to deveop 40 % area as green belt as the the proposed site was located in Severely Polluted area. Therefore, PP proposed to exclude land area of NDZ falling in CRZ-III from the existing plot and requested to reduce the greenbelt area from 40 % to 33 % area stating that SIPCOT, Cuddalore is no longer Severely Polluted area mentioning the letter dated 22.09.2021 from TNPCB to SIPCOT on Cuddalore stating CEPI score of 55.25 and 31.12 for the years 2019 and 2020. The committee opined that as per OM dated 05.07.2022, PP shall maintain 40 % of the total project area as greenbelt as sufficient land has been acquired.
- To compensate shortage of area, PP informed that Industry has acquired additional area of 18818 sq. m (4.65 acres) from its sister company M/s. Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited which is contiguous to the proposed project site.
- EAC suggested PP to furnish copy of application submitted for amendment in the existing EC letter No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6788/5(e)/EC-69/2019 dated 19.11.2019 for reduction in total plot area. Accordingly, PP has submitted copy of application No. SIA/TN/IND2/300360/2023 for amendment of reduction in total plot area by 7.2 acres i.e 29137 square metres which is more than required area for addition in proposed project 4.65 acres i.e 18818 square metres. As sufficient land has been applied for reduction in area of sister company, EAC suggested that PP should meet 40% requirement of total project area as greenbelt.
- The land for the project has been obtained on sub-lease from sister company M/s. Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited (CCVL) which granted EC for PVC plant of production capacity of 600000 TPA isued by SIEAA Tamil Nadu vide letter SEIAA-TN/F.No.6788/5(e)/EC-69/2019 letter dated 19.11.2019 with a total project area of 69.4 acres. PP has informed that the Industry has taken the land for lease from M/s CCVL for a period of 14 years. PP has also informed that M/s. CCVL has submitted an undertaking to extend the lease period for 15 more years after completion of lease period of 14 years.
- PP vide email dated 17.05,2023 submitted an undertaking stating that the no area of the additional plot of the proposed amendment is falling in CRZ area.
- EAC suggested to remove invasive species proposed as a part of greenbelt. Accordingly, PP has submitted revised list of species list removing invasive species.

After detailed deliberations EAC found the justification for amendment sought satisfactory and recommended for amendment in EC for inclusion of 4.65 acres i.e 18818 square metres contiguous land from sister company M/s. Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited (CCVL) and deduction of 7204 square metres area (i.e NDZ of CRZ III) subject to the following additional conditions:

- (i) The green belt of at least 5-10 m width shall be developed in 40 % of the total project area with tree density @ 2500 trees per hectares, mainly along the plant periphery after inclusion of land area from sister company M/s. Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited (CCVL).
- (ii) As committed, PP shall obatain amendment EC letter No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6788/5(e)/EC-69/2019 dated 19.11.2019 for reduction in total plot area of 7.2 acres.

(iii) PP shall sensitize and create awareness among the people working within the project area as well as its surrounding area on the ban of Single Use Plastic in order to ensure the compliance of Notification published by MOEFCC on 12th August, 2021. A report along with photographs on the measures taken shall also be included in the six-monthly compliance report being submitted to concerned authority.

The EAC, in its meeting held on 16.05.2023, based on information & clarifications provided by the project proponent and after detailed deliberations recommended the proposal for grant of amendment in Environment Clearance subject to additional EC condition subject to additional conditions under the provision of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.

- 7. The MoEF&CC has examined the proposal in accordance with the extant provisions of the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto and based on the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee hereby accords amendment in Environment Clearance dated 26.11.2021 for the instant proposal to M/s. Chemplast Sanmar Limited under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof subject to compliance of EC conditions, general instructions issued vide EC letter dated 26.11.2021 and EC identification number IA/TN/IND2/427770/2023 and additional EC Conditions. However, all other terms and conditions mentioned in EC identification no. EC21A020TN119228 vide dated 16.11.2021 shall remain unchanged.
- 8. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Additional EC Conditions

- 1. The green belt of at least 5-10 m width shall be developed in 40 % of the total project area with tree density @ 2500 trees per hectares, mainly along the plant periphery after inclusion of land area from sister company M/s. Chemplast Cuddalore Vinyls Limited (CCVL).
- 2. As committed, PP shall obatain amendment EC letter No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6788/5(e)/EC-69/2019 dated 19.11.2019 for reduction in total plot area of 7.2 acres.
- 3. PP shall sensitize and create awareness among the people working within the project area as well as its surrounding

area on the ban of Single Use Plastic in order to ensure the compliance of Notification published by MOEFCC on 12th August, 2021. A report along with photographs on the measures taken shall also be included in the six-monthly compliance report being submitted to concerned authority.

4. As committed, NDZ area shall be left in natural state and no activity will be carried out in NDZ area without approval from competent authority.
